FIRST READING: A READING FROM GENESIS, CHAPTER 1, BEGINNING AT VERSE 1

In the beginning when God created the heavens and the earth, the earth was a formless void and darkness covered the face of the deep, while a wind from God swept over the face of the waters. And God saw that the light was good; and God separated the light from the darkness. ***This is the Word of the Lord.***

THE EPISTLE: 2 CORINTHIANS, CHAPTER 13, BEGINNING AT VERSE 11

Finally, brothers and sisters, farewell. Put things in order, listen to my appeal, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you. Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the saints greet you. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you. ***This is the Word of the Lord.***

THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW, CHAPTER 28, BEGINNING AT VERSE 16

Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. When they saw him, they worshipped him; but some doubted. And Jesus came and said to them, 'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age.' ***This is the Gospel of the Lord.***
